REINSPECTION SUMMARY

On October 27, 2023 PBS Engineering and Environmental Inc. (PBS) completed the AHERA three-year reinspection at Memorial Elementary School in McMinnville, Oregon. The reinspection was completed in accordance with the requirements of 40 CFR, Part 763, Asbestos-Containing Materials in Schools; Final Rule and Notice. AHERA-accredited inspector, Taylor Cook, performed the reinspection.

During the summer of 2016 PBS completed a comprehensive pre-renovation asbestos survey at Memorial Elementary School. The scope of the renovations that followed did not impact the identified asbestos-containing materials; no abatement was performed.

- Asbestos-containing pipe insulation remains in the central mechanical room. The pipe insulation was
 observed in good condition. Additional pipe insulation may remain in other concealed locations in
 the school.
- The air cell duct insulation located in the main hall fan room has been removed. However, debris and remnant material remain between the walls. The air cell duct insulation located in the ceiling above the halls is inaccessible but is assumed to remain in place.
- Asbestos-containing vinyl floor tile and associated mastic remains throughout the main building. The floor tile is overlaid with carpet in most locations.
- Asbestos-containing tan sheet flooring was found in the gymnasium storage room next to the gymnasium bathroom, various bathrooms and a custodial closet. The sheet floor covering was in good condition at the time of this inspection with localized damage in the bathroom across from classroom 18.

All known or suspect asbestos-containing materials should continue to be maintained under the school district's AHERA Asbestos Management Plan.
