Curriculum Department Goals for 2021–2022 Kourtney Ferrua Focusing on the Core Initiative which are the six hives of intention. They have remained stable, we enhance each year and go deeper. Each standard has a goal. This is an adoption year for ELA for K–12, and we are working with consultant Angela Perry this fall to do an English Language Arts 6–12 grade review. The results come out in December and we will work with educators to identify where areas of strength are and gaps and opportunities to move forward with the adoption..
