Subcommittee reports

Janis spoke about the facilities report. The Wascher fire system water line was replaced for the modular building. The walk through at the high school took place and there is only a short list to deal with. There are three tents now and they will be put up soon and go up at the high school, Wascher and Memorial. They are replacing 13,000 filters that will be replaced at the school district after the poor air quality caused by Oregon wildfires.

During the policy subcommittee meeting, they reviewed part time students, board meetings, and transportation policies.

For fiscal, they covered enrollment and there is a new report coming out in October. Auditors are here this week for the yearly audit.

For instructional improvement subcommittee, they discussed schedules. They also reviewed collaborative problem solving.
